6. ALL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES, INCLUDING THE INSTALLATION OF CITY RAINWATER SYSTEMS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS AND APPROVAL OF A CITY OF WHEELING.
7. ALL SANITARY SEWER SHALL BE CONSTRUCTED WITH CLASS "X" MODIFIED BEDDING UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.
8. WHEREVER THE DRAINAGE BATH DOES NOT AFFORD SUFFICIENT BEARING STRENGTH TO SUPPORT THE PROPOSED STRUCTURE, THE EXISTING SUBGRADE SHALL BE REINFORCED, EXCAVATED AND STABILIZED WITH A 12 INCH THICK MASONRY LAYER OF CRUSHED STONE.
9. THE COMPACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE LOCATION AND DEPTH OF ALL EXISTING UTILITIES PRIOR TO ANY CONSTRUCTION OF CONSTRUCTION AND PROPOSED FACILITIES FOR THE PROJECT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MAINTAIN AN UNDERGROUND UTILITY DETECTION REGISTRATION AT 1-800-272-7000.
10. CONVEYANCE FACILITIES SHALL BE DESIGNED TO EXIST DURING DRESS, VEGETATION AND NATURAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE TRAIL.
11. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOCATING ALL EXISTING UTILITIES AND SHALL NOTIFY ALL UTILTY COMPANIES BEFORE COMMENCING WORK. (SEE NOTE 5) THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING NECESSARY PERMITS FROM THE PROPERTY OWNER PRIOR TO ANY CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT. PROGRESSIVE LAKE SHALL HAVE THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE PROPERTY OWNER DIRECTLY INVOLVED.
12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR RESTORING, MAINTAIN, THE SOILING, STAKING, TIEBACKS, AND STAKING ALL WEIRS OCCURRING AS PART OF THE PROJECT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REMOVAL OF ALL WEIR MATERIALS AS PART OF THE PROJECT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS AS SET FORTH BY THE COUNTY ENGINEER AND/OR THE NEXT BEST AVAILABLE REPLACEMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.
13. INSPECTION OF OR FAILURE TO INSPECT ANY MATERIALS OR WORKMANSHIP BY DATE OF COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR. THE CONTRACTOR HAS HIS RESPONSIBILITIES TO PERFORM THE WORK IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS OR LISTS.
14. PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION, ALL SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES SHALL BE INSTALLED AND MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE CONSTRUCTION PROCESS. THE PUBLIC LAKE OF WTS, ALL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PRACTICES SHALL BE LEFT IN PLACE UNTIL CONSTRUCTION IS COMPLETE OR THE AREA IS STABILIZED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE SOIL CONSERVATION SERVICE'S RECOMMENDATIONS.
15. ALL UTILITIES INCLUDING TELEPHONE, TELETYPE AND CABLE TELEVISION SHALL BE LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED PRIOR TO ANY CONSTRUCTION OF THE PROJECT. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MARKING ALL UTILITIES THAT ARE FOUND BY THE SURVEYOR. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL GUARANTEE ALL EXISTENCE OF OR NON-EXISTENCE OF THE SANITARY SEWER AND WATER MAINS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE LOCATION OF SUCH MAINS AND APPLICABLE FINES AND/OR CONTRACTORS TO VERIFY THE LOCATION OF SUCH MAINS AND
